PLEASE NOTE:

- Tables are **not** included in Pitch (except for Market Hall & New Producer's Market.) If you would like to hire a table, there will be a £5 charge per table, bookable on the Further Information Form if selected.
- Weekend **Catering Fee** (*blanket fee for all caterers selling hot food/cold food for immediate consumption*) = £150 **in addition** to area prices listed below *except for The Priory.
- **Alcohol Sales Fee** (*the alcohol sales fee is for wet sales only: selling drinks for immediate consumption or/and in open containers/vessels. This fee covers the admin and fee of your TENS licence required to sell alcohol at the festival.*) = £150 **in addition** to area prices listed below *unless stated
- **Own Marquees or Units:** Subject to space and not permitted in all sites – please see specific sites for details. *Any own units larger than standard single sizes stated below will incur additional charges applied per extra meter.

PAYMENT DETAILS & DEADLINES

There is a non-refundable deposit of £50 payable upon receipt of an Offer notice to confirm your acceptance, this is due by **Monday 29th April 2019**. This deposit will be deducted from your pitch fee invoice. If you cancel after paying the deposit, it will be retained. If you fail to pay the full fee due by the deadlines, the deposit will be kept as a penalty fee and the amount added back on to your final invoice.

Invoices will be issued to traders who have been selected on **Thursday 2nd May 2019**. Payment is due by **Friday 31st May** (if paying in full).

If paying in 2 instalments on our payment plan a 5% admin fee will be applied to the pitch fee. The first 50%, plus 2.5% admin fee, will be due by **Friday 31st May**, with the remaining 50%, plus 2.5% admin fee, due by **Monday 1st July 2019**.

Other payment plans may be available to New Producers (trading for less than 2 years) and Small producers (under £20k turnover per year), by advance approval of the festival accountant only.

Failure to make payment by these dates, unless in special circumstances agreed in advance with the festival accountant and trader manager, will

Rate Card

ELECTRICITY

Paid in advance: For the first 16 amps = £90 for Fri – Sun power. If electricity not required on the Friday, fee is reduced to £70
£70 per subsequent 16 amps

On the day electricity costs (if not booked & paid for in advance): For the first 16 amps = £120 for Fri – Sun. £100 per subsequent 16 amps

CHILLER HOOK-UP

Small fridges/chiller units that can fit within your pitch size are encouraged, rather than chiller vans/large units.

For larger units or chiller vans there are limited spaces available (1 or 2 per site [except for LBY = max. 4]). These must be agreed in advance by the festival. These will be located off-site, within walking distance of your pitch for a charge of £100 per hook up. These are strictly allocated on a first come, first served basis and will affect where we are able to site you.

TABLES - £5 each if booked in advance; £10 on the day (except for New Producer's Market & Market Hall where tables are included in pitch fee)
